Science: floods, geology, creation/evolution, boats, buoyancy, the animals of creation, "kinds," rainbows, storms; Bible: the Bible and science	November 1, 2009
July/August 2010	The Potter and the Clay ~ Isaiah 64:8	As we get back to school, we must see that God is crafting each child into what He wants them to be through our homeschooling. Art: crafts, artworks; Bible: God's handiwork, God's creativity, God's sovereignty, reflecting God's image by being creative; Homemaking: creating order beauty and from chaos; Family: the uniqueness of every child	January 1, 2010
September/October 2010	A Tree Planted by the Rivers ~ Psalm 1:3	As the leaves change color, we see our children are like trees that we feed and water with rich soil and life-giving water in our homes. Science: fruit, seasons, trees, leaves, rivers, water; Mothers: seasons of fruitfulness; Bible: good counsel, delighting in the law; Life skills: prospering	March 1, 2010
November/December 2010	Signs and Seasons ~ Genesis 1:14	The holiday season is a good time to see God's hand in our times and to teach that to our children.
